Cincinnati Mayor Cranley on Eagle Scout Day!**

**CINCINNATI, OH – June 12, 2019** – It takes a lot of dedication and time to become an Eagle Scout, the Boy Scouts of America’s highest rank. 25 of these local Eagle Scouts, and their parents, had the opportunity to gather and visit the Cincinnati City Council for Eagle Scout Day earlier today. During their visit, they met with Cincinnati Mayor John Cranley and Cincinnati Chair Councilwoman Amy Murray before going into Council Chambers. Councilwoman Amy Murray spoke with the group about the importance of citizenship and community; and the Scouts shared some of the notable impact their projects have had on the local community. She also shared that all three Citizenship Merit Badges (*Citizenship in the Community, Nation, and World*), are required for Scouts to earn the rank of Eagle Scout. The Eagle Scouts and parents were congratulated by Mayor Cranley, and each one of the Eagle Scouts were recognized and given a proclamation by Councilwoman Amy Murray.
