DEN CHIEF TRAINING OFFERED AGAIN IN 2020!

Den Chief Training is offered at the Scouting U. Scouts BSA/Venturers, who serve as a Den Chief, are a key part of the leadership team for Cub Scouts and Webelos. A well-trained Den Chief is often a key to retaining Scouts and inspiring them to continue into Scouts BSA Troops. Den Chief training will include games, skits, songs, and how to support the Den Leader. Den Chiefs can attend by registering for the Den Chief Training being offered. Confirm your participation with your Scoutmaster and then submit a completed registration. Walk-in Registration is not available for this course – preregistration is required. **Den Chief Course will end at approximately 11:20 am.**

How will I choose my courses?

Below you will see the structure of the entire day. There are courses in leader position specific training, Cub Scout, Scouts BSA, Venturing, Commissioners, Scouting Skills, and overall Scouting Enrichment. Choose courses that you are interested in, or courses that will help your unit, or take courses in a training tract. Plan out your schedule; however, be careful, some courses are more than one session long, then register online.

Class sessions are 50 minutes long unless otherwise noted in the course guide.

Several classes cover multiple sessions or all 6 sessions. Please check the course guide for any class length and plan accordingly.

There will be a 10-minute break between classes. Courses are only offered during sessions shown - please make sure that the course you select is offered during the time you are scheduling it! **Most courses are limited in size and are filled on a first come, first served basis**. Please note that some courses with low registration numbers may be cancelled. We will get you into another class... just watch your email for any updates. When registering, please make sure you give us an email that you regularly check.

Accessing Classes

Classes will be delivered virtually through a variety of online platforms including $\underline{\textbf{Google}}$ $\underline{\textbf{Classrooms}}$ and $\underline{\textbf{Zoom}}$.

Approximately a week before the event, each registered participant will receive an email with the links to each class they have registered for. Please do not share these links – only those registered for the class will be able to attend.
