Answering this call for help could not be more urgent. According to the Freestore Foodbank, one in seven of our neighbors in the Tri-State area is at risk of hunger.

Dan Beard Council Scouting For Food: How Does it Work?

On **Saturday, November 6, 2021**, Packs, Troops and Posts will fan out across their local neighborhoods, circulating flyers asking for non-perishable food donations.

On the following **Saturday, November 13, 2021**, units will return to the homes where flyers were placed to collect the donations, which then will be dropped off at food pantries and Freestore Foodbank affiliated agencies in the units' home district.
