

DBC CHARTER RENEWAL 2023

What is Charter Renewal?/Why Renew

- Annual renewal of agreements with charter organizations
- Roster clean up
- Collection of BSA membership fees for following year
- Review and adjust adult leader positions





TIMELINE

- August 1 Online Charter Renewal System Opens
- August 3 Charter Renewal Kick-Off
- August 3 through September
 - Reconcile roster
 - Collect membership fees from returning Scouts and volunteers
 - Review Youth protection training
 - Review Scout Life Subscriptions
 - Login to the recharter system
- Late September until October 15
 - Finalize online roster
 - Charter Organization Rep signs charter
- October 18-26 District turn in events
 - Printed copy with payment turned in at district turn in event
- October 27 Council Deadline for Filing Charter Renewals





YOUTH PROTECTION TRAINING

The Dan Beard Council has committed to having 100% of its volunteer leaders youth protection trained at all times. Therefore, volunteers that have not renewed their YPT by the expiration date will not be renewed.

 All volunteers should have YPT expiration dates of 1/1/24 or later before submitting charter renewal online.





RECONCILNG ROSTER

- Use My.Scouting to get an accurate up to date roster
 - Visit <u>www.danbeard.org/charterrenewal</u> for directions on accessing your roster
- Any missing members have 2 options to be added
 - Paper applications submitted to the council office with the all applicable fees.
 - Online applications can be used in lieu of paper.





UNIT PROCESSOR NEXT STEPS

- Review Roster and submit applications for any additional/missing adults or youth to council service center with applicable fees
- Collect any necessary fees from returning members
- Review youth protection status for all adults
- Consult with any other units at your charter org and determine primary registration unit for multiple adults





ONLINE SYSTEM

Only unit Key 3 members and Key 3 delegates will be able to access the online recharter system

FINALIZING THE ONLINE CHARTER

- Verify your Scout Life subscriptions and multiple members before submitting
- Once you complete the online portion of the renewal, you will need to select "Pay at Council", then click the "Pay and Post" button.
- Once you have clicked "Pay and Post" the key 3 will receive and email requesting signatures.
- At this point, the online process is complete. You will not be able to make any further adjustments to the online charter.





SUBMITTING THE CHARTER TO DBC

- Once you have clicked "Pay and Post" the key 3, key 3 delegate and/or COR delegate will receive and email requesting signatures, there are 2 options for signatures.
 - Any of the above listed individuals may sign the document if approval has been discussed with the COR, or the COR may sign (preferred)
- Print a copy of your final recharter paperwork that is emailed to you





ITEMS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT CHARTER

- Printed copy final of the Charter Renewal
- Fees (Check is preferred, a 2% Credit card processing fee will be added)
- Any supporting documents such as Background check forms, applications or youth protection training certificates (for new adults only)
- Annual Agreement signed by the Executive officer and Charter Org Rep



Pro Tip: Paying at the council service center allows for fee adjustments to be handled in a timely manner.



FREE ADVANCEMENT

- On time and error free charter renewal packet-Due on October 27.
- <u>JTE Bronze level or higher</u>. JTE Forms are due December 31- No exceptions
- A <u>detailed assessment/JTE</u> conducted with your unit commissioner (or another commissioner if your unit is not assigned a commissioner) by December 31.
- A specific <u>FOS presentation</u> date to be scheduled to occur between November 1, 2023, and no later than March 31, 2024 – No exceptions.

FEE DEADLINE EXTENSION

- For units participating in the popcorn sale that have scouts using popcorn funds to assist with payment of registration fees, the deadline for payment only is extended until 11/17/23.
- All Charter Renewal Paperwork and associated forms are still due by 10/27/23.





2023 FEE CHANGES

New National Fees are in effect. This means:

- Fees will be paid for 12 months
 - Youth \$80.00
 - One-time new applicant fee \$25.00 (Youth Only)
 - Adults \$60.00
 - Insurance \$5.50 (Youth and Adults)
 - Scout Life: \$15.00
 - Charter Renewal Fee: \$100.00
- Units will be able to pay online.
