## HOW TO ACCESS THE OHIO ACE EDUCATIONAL SAVINGS PROGRAM:



1 Visit <https://education.ohio.gov/Topics/Other-Resources/Scholarships/ACE/Ohio-ACE-How-to-Apply> to begin the application process with ACE. You will need to apply with ACE to determine eligibility, and then apply with “Merit” which is the service provider for Ohio that administers the fund and reimburses approved expenses. The process can take up to two weeks according to the website.
