

## Dan Beard Council (DBC) Eagle Scout Association (ESA) Scholarship Application Procedures and Requirements

#### **Procedures:**

- 1. The Eagle Scout applying for a scholarship must personally complete the application.
- 2. Complete the official scholarship application and enclose only the items requested in the requirements. Additional pages will not be considered.
- 3. Answer all questions as fully as possible.
- 4. Directly type all responses into the application file. The application should not exceed four pages in length.
- 5. When finished you must email the final application to: sheri.greenlee@scouting.org.
- 6. Applications submitted by March 31 will be considered. You will receive an email notification when your application is received.
- 7. Applications become the property of the selection committee and will not be returned.
- 8. Submitting an application does not guarantee a scholarship will be granted. The decision of the committee is final.

#### **Requirements:**

- 1. Be an Eagle Scout and have received credentials from the National Council.
- 2. Be a graduating high school senior or an undergraduate college student who is not currently in their senior college year.
- 3. Submit: High school transcript and ACT/SAT test scores.
- 4. Submit an application by March 31.
- 5. Provide one signed recommendation from a volunteer or Scout Leader.
- 6. Have demonstrated leadership in Scouting and have a strong record of participation in activities outside of Scouting.
- 7. The applicant must have received the Eagle Award in a troop registered in the Dan Beard Council or have been active in the Dan Beard Council for the past two years.
- 8. The selection committee may (if necessary) conduct interviews of the finalists.
